

TARGET & RECOVERY COMPARISON




## CELEBRATING CULTURE DAY

## MEETING OF THE SPECIAL DEPARTMENTAL ACCOUNTS COMMITTEE (SDAC)



A meeting of the Special Departmental Accounts Committee (SDAC) was held on 21.03.2025 under the chairmanship of the Additional Secretary (Admn), Excise and Taxation. The committee reviewed the progress on Audit report on GIS Integrated Computerization of Urban Immovable Property Tax System in Excise & Taxation Narcotics Control Punjab. The department remains committed to ensuring compliance with the directions issued by the Chairman of the SDAC.

## RECRUITMENT OF 124 EXCISE & TAXATION CONSTABLES

The Excise & Taxation Department is entrusted with key responsibilities, including the registration and transfer of motor vehicles, as well as the collection of token taxes. Additionally, the department plays a vital role in the recovery of property tax, which contributes significantly to various government projects.

To strengthen its operational capacity and improve service delivery. The recruitment of 124 E&T Constables has been completed. This recruitment drive was carried out in collaboration with the Punjab Police, ensuring a fair, secure, and transparent process. The selection took place across multiple cities in Punjab and involved a rigorous assessment process, including physical evaluations, endurance test, written examinations, and formal interviews. Total 124 positions appointed out of 9002 applicants, 91 were filled on open merit, 29 were reserved under the women quota, and 4 positions were allocated for minority candidates. This inclusive initiative reflects the department's commitment



to merit-based hiring while promoting diversity and equitable representation within its workforce. This strategic induction is expected to significantly support the department's ongoing initiatives and ensure the efficient execution of its core functions.

## CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY



International Women's Day was observed on Sun, Mar 8, 2026 in the Directorate General of E&T, a panel discussion was held and attended by women officers off all cadre. # ESTABLISHMENT OF NARCOTICS CONTROL STATIONS IN PUNJAB

After approval of the Government, the Punjab Counter Narcotics Force (CNF) has already been established. Punjab CNF consists of professionally trained and experienced serving and retired army personnel headed by a serving Brigadier posted on secondment as DG (NC) / Commander of Punjab CNF. Headquarter of the force has been established at Lahore. Now CNF has established its Narcotics Control Stations at divisional headquarter of Lahore, Rawalpindi and Multan. Necessary measures/steps are being taken to make these NCS fully operational in order to monitor and control the drug abuse.
