

The District Planning & Design Committee's meeting held on 15.04.2015 under the chairmanship of Commissioner Faisalabad Division, Faisalabad recommended the Peri-Urban Structure Plan-2035 (FPUSP-35). Consequent upon the recommendation of DPDC the Honorable House of Zila Council, Faisalabad has approved the Peri-Urban Structure Plan-2035 (FPUSP-35) under section-30 of Land Use (Classification / Re Classification & Re-Development) Rules, 2009 vide Resolution dated 25-04-2015.

The following decisions of DPDC are being notified with immediate effect in best interest of public.

- (i) The Faisalabad Peri-Urban Structure Plan-2035 will not supersede any Master Plan of Faisalabad in future.
- (ii) The original status of plots in FDA City (a project of FDA) will remain unchanged.
- (iii) Regardless of area, service road of 30 feet right of way (ROW) will be the part of all housing schemes parallel to the intercity roads in order to avoid traffic congestion.
- (iv) Structure roads along the expressway and on newly developed area will be provided at an interval of 2-km and the same land / zone is approved for mix landuse.
- (v) The delimitation of the Municipal Corporation done under the Local Govt. Ordinance 2013 must be shown in Faisalabad Peri-Urban Structure Plan-2035 by EDO(MS), Faisalabad after their notification.
