1. ABOUT SHANGHAI UNIVERSITY

It is among Shanghai's first pilot programs of high-level construction of local university. As a university with first-class discipline construction qualified by the Ministry of Education, SHU is ranked 201-300 globally in the 2025 Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), 296th in US News World University Rankings 2025.

2. BASIC INFORMATION ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Chinese Government Scholarship Bilateral program accords with the cooperation and exchange agreements or consensus reached by the Chinese government and the governments and institutions of other nations. This scholarship program referred to as CSC-type A.

- **Application accepting institution:** Apply to the dispatching authorities for overseas study of your home country, such as educational department, Chinese embassy.
- **Application time:** Generally, from November 2025 to February 2026. Please consult the dispatching authorities for the specific deadline of each year.
- **Applicant:** Outstanding international students applying for undergraduates, postgraduates, general and senior scholars' programs in Shanghai University.
- **Majors under this scholarship program:** No Limit (For the major list, please refer to <https://apply.shu.edu.cn/>)
 - ✧ CSC scholarship is not available for English taught bachelor program.





3. SCHOLARSHIP COVERAGE

Chinese Government Scholarship Bilateral program provides both full scholarships and partial scholarships. For more detailed information, please refer to <https://www.campuschina.org>

3.1 Full Scholarship

- Tuition fees in the standard length of schooling
- Free university dormitory or accommodation subsidy (CNY 700/month for undergraduates, master's students and general scholars; CNY 1,000/month for doctoral students and senior scholars)
- Stipend:
 - Undergraduates: CNY 2,500 per month;
 - Master's students/general scholars: CNY 3,000 per month;
 - Doctoral students/senior scholars: CNY 3,500 per month.
- Comprehensive medical insurance: CNY 800 per person per year; CNY 400 per person (for programs lasting less than six months)

3.2 Partial Scholarship

Notes:

- ✧ Stipend is monthly paid by Shanghai University. Scholarship students who register before the 15th (15th included) of the registration month will receive full stipend; those who register after the 15th will receive half stipend. Graduates can get another half month stipend after the graduation day determined by the university. If scholarship students have left China for more than 15 days due to personal reasons during his/her study period (except public holidays), his/her stipend during that time will be suspended.

4. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Basic Eligibility

Be a citizen of a country other than the PRC with a valid personal ordinary-type passport and in good health both mentally and physically.

4.2 Language Proficiency

4.2.1 For Chinese-taught programs:

Have passed the HSK (Level 3) when applying for a Chinese-taught undergraduate or general scholar program (excluding Chinese language majors);

Have passed the HSK (Level 3) when applying for a Chinese-taught senior scholar program;

Have passed the HSK (Level 4) when applying for a Chinese-taught postgraduate program;

- ✧ For applicants who do not meet the language proficiency requirements for admission to Shanghai University Chinese taught programs, will first take one-year Chinese foundation program. Only after passing the examination and meet the language proficiency requirements can be admitted to the degree/ non-degree program.
- ✧ The language proficiency requirements for admission to Shanghai University Chinese taught programs:

Chinese Language (BA), and Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BA)	HSK 4 above 180
Science, Engineering, Economics, Management & Arts	HSK 5 above 180

4.2.2 For English-taught programs:

Applicants must meet one of the following English proficiency requirements:

- Native speakers of English.
- Internationally recognized English proficiency tests score within two years:

- The previous degree is fully taught in English. Applicant should provide the statement of instruction language issued by the official department of the school or university, and the statement must be on official headed paper.

4.3 Academic and age requirement

4.3.1 For undergraduate program

- ✓ Be an academically excellent holder of high school diploma, GPA 3.0 or above (Note: 4-Point GPA System) ;
- ✓ For Science or Engineering programs, applicants are qualified in mathematics and physics in high school. Some programs also require computer programming courses record. For Economics or Management programs, applicants are qualified in mathematics in high school. For Arts programs, applicants are required to submit his/her portfolio (such as paintings, story scripts, short movies, etc.).
- ✓ Applicants should be under the age of 25.

4.3.2 For Master's Programs

- ✓ Be an academically excellent holder of a Bachelor's degree;
- ✓ Relevant undergraduate academic background is required, or have completed undergraduate-level courses relevant to intended graduate major, with GPA 2.5 or above (Note: 4-Point GPA System) .
- ✓ Students applying to art majors must have relative academic background and submit a portfolio (such as paintings, story scripts, short movies, etc.).
- ✓ Applicants should be under the age of 35.

4.3.3 For PhD's Programs

- ✓ Be an academically excellent holder of a Master's degree;
- ✓ Relevant master's degree background and academic achievements, with GPA 3.0 or above (Note: 4-Point GPA System) .
- ✓ Students applying to art majors must have relative academic background and submit a portfolio (such as paintings, story scripts, short movies, etc.).
- ✓ Applicants should be under the age of 40.

4.3.4 For general scholar program

- ✓ Be a holder of a high school diploma (or higher).
- ✓ Under the age of 45 when applying for a general scholar program.



4.3.5 For senior scholar program

- ✓ Be a master's degree holder or an associate professor (or above).
- ✓ Under the age of 50 when applying for a senior scholar program.

4.4 Take the "China Scholastic Competency Assessment (short as CSCA)" when applying for bachelor programs

Starting from the 2026/2027 academic year, applicants for undergraduate programs in China must take the "China Scholastic Competency Assessment" (CSCA) before submitting their applications, and provide a valid CSCA score report when applying. Applicants planning to enroll in undergraduate programs in September 2026 are required to register for the CSCA tests scheduled on December 21, 2025, or January 25, 2026. The CSCA score report is a mandatory document for Bachelor programs' admission review. For information about CSCA and the registration, please visit www.csc.cn.

4.5 No other type of scholarship was granted at the time of application.

5. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

The following materials should be prepared with complete and clear electronic versions.

Information Page of Ordinary Passport

A clear copy of your valid passport with your name, photo, birth date, place of birth, date of issue, date of expiry. Visa page is required for applicants who are not in their home country. An applicant shall submit a clear scanned copy of the information page of his/her passport that will not expire on or before March 1, 2027. Renew the passport if the requirement is not met.

ID photo

The passport-size photo (one-inch, 295*413) should be taken within the last six months, bareheaded, full-faced with blue-color background; the photo is required to submit as JPG image less than 100kb.

Selfie video

Applicants should submit a video including self-introduction and study plan in China. avi, mov, or mp4 less than 50 MB are accepted. The language of the video should be consistent with the language of the program you are applying for (English or Chinese).

Highest Degree Diploma and Graduation Certificate

Applicants who have not yet received their degree certificates at the time of application should provide a pre-graduation certificate issued by their school or college to prove their ability to graduate and



obtain their degree certificates by July 31, 2026. In addition, applicants are required to fill out a personal commitment form, which can be downloaded from the website: <https://apply.shu.edu.cn/application/index>

Academic transcripts

Academic records of the highest degree program shall be provided. These transcripts shall be issued and sealed by the attending high school's/university's academic affairs office, graduate school, or student management department.

CSCA score report (Only for bachelor programs)

Applicants seeking to pursue a bachelor's degree must register for and take the CSCA before the application deadline, and obtain a valid Score Report.

Language Proficiency Certificate within the validity period

If the official language proficiency is not available at the time of application, applicants may upload a screenshot of the results queried on the website. The original certificate must be provided at the time of new student registration.

Two Recommendation Letters with Signature (Only for postgraduate programs and senior scholar programs)

Two letters of recommendation (written only in Chinese or English) from professors or associate professors shall be submitted. These letters shall describe the applicant's objectives of learning in China, comprehensive abilities, and evaluation of future growth etc.; The referee's signature and contact information are necessary.

A study or research plan

A study and research plan written in Chinese or English (no less than 200 words/characters for undergraduates; no less than 500 words/characters for scholars; no less than 1000 words/characters for postgraduates). The language of study or research plan should be consistent with the language of the program you are applying for. Applicants could download the template at <https://apply.shu.edu.cn/application/index>

Statement of Financial Support

Awards (evidential materials for participation in activities or contests)

Please merge into one PDF file if there are multiple certificates.



Certificate of No Criminal Record

The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application.

Foreigner Physical Examination

* An applicant to study in China for more than six months shall submit a photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form.

* The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority and can be obtained from the dispatching authority. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take a physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

Academic Research Documents or artworks (Refer to Departmental standards)

* Published academic papers and patent certificates

* Applicants for art majors should provide at least two examples of artworks.

Notes:

- *Documents not in Chinese or English should be accompanied by Chinese/English translation provided by notarized or issuing departments;*
- *Only scanned copies of the above materials are required for application, and the original documents are required for reference at the time of registration.*
- *Uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic and valid. Applicants are recommended to use a professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by untrue, unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.*





6. APPLICATION METHODS

Step 1: Applicants should log in to the Shanghai University International Student Online Application website (<https://apply.shu.edu.cn/>) to submit their applications. After passing the application material review and online interview, applicants will receive **Pre-Admission Notice** from Shanghai University.

- ✧ Shanghai university online application system is expected to open on November 20, 2025. The application process includes filling in personal information, uploading application materials, and taking online test and so on. Please pay close attention to your application status within the system, and check your email regularly. Generally, applicants could receive feedback within 14 working days after submitting the application.
- ✧ For general and senior scholars' programs, please send the application materials to this email address: apply5@oa.shu.edu.cn for the pre-admission notice issued by the university.
- ✧ This Pre-Admission Notice can be used for applying to the CSC Type A program but does not guarantee admission to Shanghai University. The final admission is subject to the approval of the dispatching authorities for overseas study of your home country, China Scholarship Council, Shanghai University, relevant College/School and prospective supervisors.
- ✧ **CSC Type A program applicants do not need to pay the Shanghai University international student application fee CNY 500.**

Step 2: Apply to the dispatching authorities for overseas study of your home country for CSC Type A scholarship opportunity.

Step 3: Login <https://www.campuschina.org>, select the study program type - Type A and complete the online application

Step 4: Reviewed by Chinese Scholarship Council (CSC) and Shanghai University.

Step 5: Inquire about the admission results from the dispatching authorities for overseas study of your home country and wait to receive the official admission documents.

- **Applicants who are not admitted to the Chinese Government Scholarship can choose to apply for other scholarship programs of Shanghai University or self-funded programs.**





7. OTHERS

7.1 Scholarship applicants must submit their application materials directly to Shanghai University in person. Those who apply by agencies will be disqualified from scholarship.

7.2 Scholarship recipients must complete the registration and enrollment on scheduled time in accordance with the university regulations. Those who miss the deadline without approval will be disqualified from scholarship.

7.3 Scholarship recipients must bring **all original documents** for registration (photocopies and digital files are not accepted). Provision of any false/ misleading information or failure to provide the requested supporting documents will lead to disqualification of admission.

7.4 Scholarship recipients are required to attend the annual scholarship review, which evaluates the academic performance and daily performance for the whole academic year. Those who fail to pass will lose their eligibility for the next year's scholarship.

7.5 Scholarship recipients cannot change the study level, major, instruction language, the length of study or transfer to another University in principle.

7.6 Those items shall be explained by the college of International Education, Shanghai University.

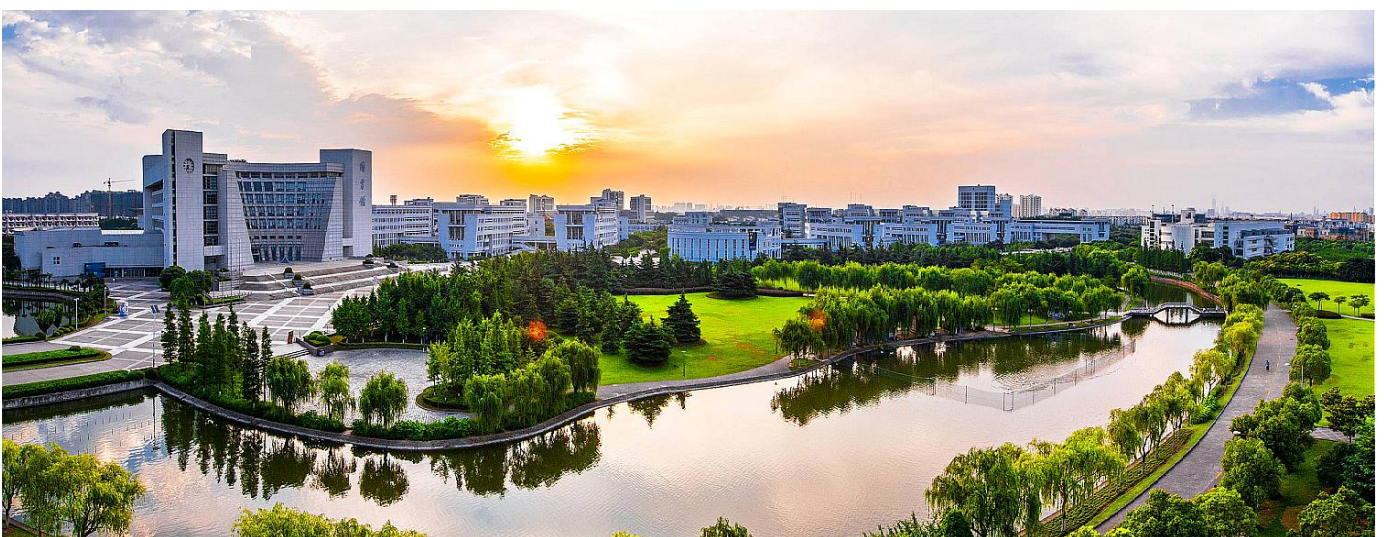

2. Scholarship Supporting Categories and Major

In order to strengthen mutual understanding and friendship between the Chinese and people around the world and promote China's exchange and cooperation with other countries in various fields, the Chinese government sets up scholarships for talented students and scholars to pursue higher education or conduct research in Chinese universities. The China Scholarship Council (hereinafter referred to as "CSC"), entrusted by China's Ministry of Education, is responsible for the admission, enrollment and administration of Chinese Government Scholarship recipients.

Chinese Government Scholarship Program-High Level Postgraduate Program is based on the principles of "individual application, institutional recommendation, expert assessment and selection on the basis of merit", and selects international students with excellent academic background, professional ability and future development potential.

- This scholarship program is only for new international students of **Master and Doctoral Programs**.
- Majors under this scholarship program: **No Limit** (Please refer to application guide for postgraduate programs, <https://apply.shu.edu.cn>)

4. Scholarship Eligibility

Applicants are required to meet the following conditions:

4.1 Basic Eligibility

Be a citizen of a country other than the PRC with a valid personal ordinary-type passport and in good health both mentally and physically.

4.2 Language Proficiency

4.2.1 For **programs taught in Chinese**, HSK certificates within two years are required (HSK refers to Chinese Proficiency Test. You can find information on: www.chinesetest.cn):

- **HSK 5 with the score 210 or above** for majors in **Science or Engineering, Economics or Management and Art**;
- **HSK 6 with the score 180 or above** for majors in **Humanities**.

❖ HSK Exemptions

The following types of applicants are exempt from taking the HSK:

- Native speaker of Chinese;
- The previous degree is fully taught in Chinese. Applicant should provide the statement of instruction language issued by the official department of the school or university, and the statement must be on official headed paper.

4.2.2 For **programs taught in English**, applicants must meet one of the following English proficiency requirements:

- Native speakers of English.
- Internationally recognized English proficiency tests score within two years:

4.3 Academic Requirement

4.3.1 For Master's Programs

- ✓ Be an academically excellent holder of a Bachelor's degree;

Applicants who have not yet received their degree certificates at the time of application should provide a pre-graduation certificate issued by their school or college to prove their ability to graduate and obtain their degree certificates by July 31, 2026. In addition, applicants are required to fill out a personal commitment form, which can be downloaded from the website: <https://apply.shu.edu.cn/application/index>

- ✓ Relevant undergraduate academic background is required, or have completed undergraduate-level courses relevant to intended graduate major, with GPA 2.5 or above (4-Point GPA System) .
- ✓ Accepted by a prospective professor at Shanghai University

Choose supervisor online when choosing a major in the online application system and get accepted by a prospective professor. Please note that it is not required to choose supervisor for the following Master's programs: School of Economics, School of Management, MBA center, College of International Education and SILC Business School. The schools/colleges will arrange the supervisor for new students after registration at Shanghai University.

- ✓ To apply for an art-related major must have relative academic background and provide a portfolio such as paintings, story scripts, short films, etc.
- ✓ Applicants should be under the age of 35.

4.3.2 For PhD's Programs

- ✓ Be an academically excellent holder of a Master's degree;

Applicants who have not yet received their degree certificates at the time of application should provide a pre-graduation certificate issued by their school or college to prove their ability to graduate and obtain their degree certificates by July 31, 2026. 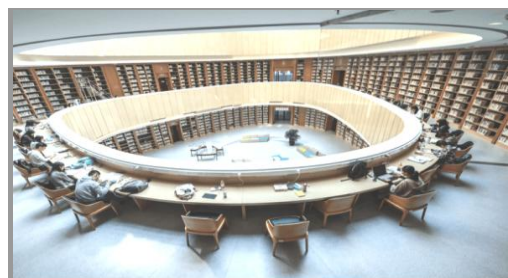

4.1 Basic Eligibility

Be a citizen of a country other than the PRC with a valid personal ordinary-type passport and in good health both mentally and physically.

According to Nationality Law and the regulations of the Ministry of Education of China, applicants who have international nationality at birth, one or both parents is Chinese citizen and are applying to Shanghai University as international students for Bachelor program, must present valid passport or citizenship documents attained before April 30, 2022 and proof of renunciation of Chinese nationality, along with proof of residence abroad of at least 2 years between April 30, 2022 and April 30, 2026 (9 months of residence abroad per year may be considered as one year).

Residents of mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan who have emigrated to other countries and are applying to Shanghai University as international students for Bachelor program, must present valid passport or citizenship documents attained before April 30, 2022 and proof of their renunciation of Chinese nationality, along with proof of residence abroad of at least 2 years between April 30, 2022 and April 30, 2026 (9 months of residence abroad per year may be considered as one year).

Relevant applicants are required to provide supporting documents such as birth certificates, entry and exit seals records, certificate of renunciation and Commitment Letter for Entry Exit Information (You can download a <https://apply.shu.edu.cn>). Those who fail to pass the nationality status review will automatically lose the eligibility to apply and any subsequent admission results they may obtain.

4.2 Language Proficiency

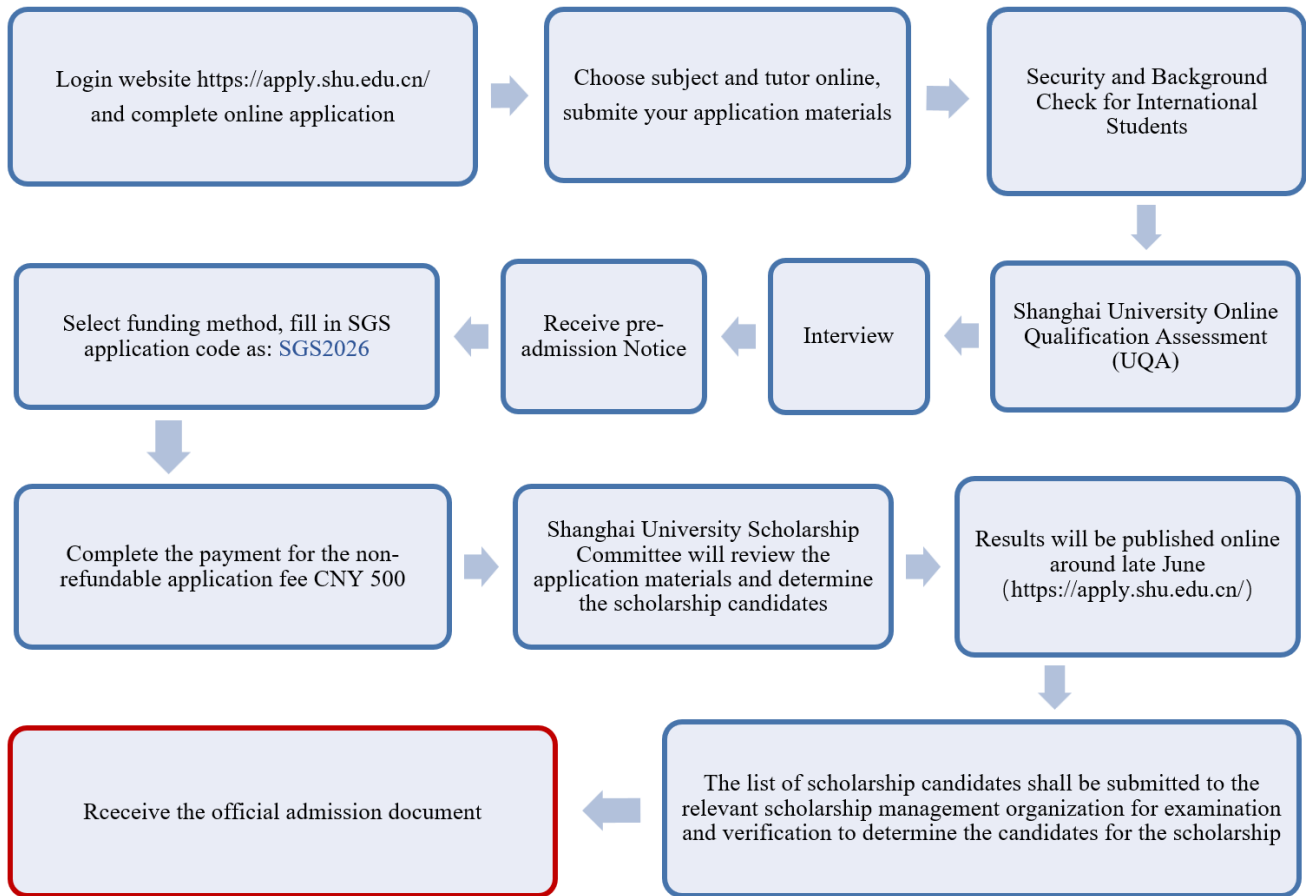

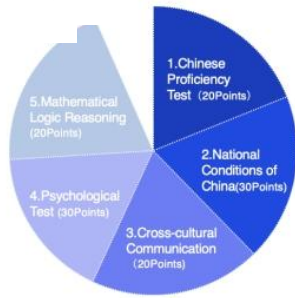


- **Shanghai University Security and Background Check (SBC) for International Students**

- **University Qualification Assessment (UQA) for International Students**

According to the regulations of the Ministry of Education of China, those who immigrated to other countries from the Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macao or Taiwan and applying to study in Shanghai University as international students, should meet the following additional requirements: the applicants must hold valid passport or other relevant international recognized documents for at least 4 years; meanwhile, in the latest 4 years (by each April 30th of the year of University registration), the applicants must have lived overseas for 2 years (Living overseas for 9 months can be converted to 1 year, which is subject to the exit-entry stamp on visa.).

Be between the ages of 16 and 35 (as of September 1, 2026). The age limit is extended to 45 for in-service Chinese language teachers, while applicants for undergraduate scholarships must generally be under the age of 25.

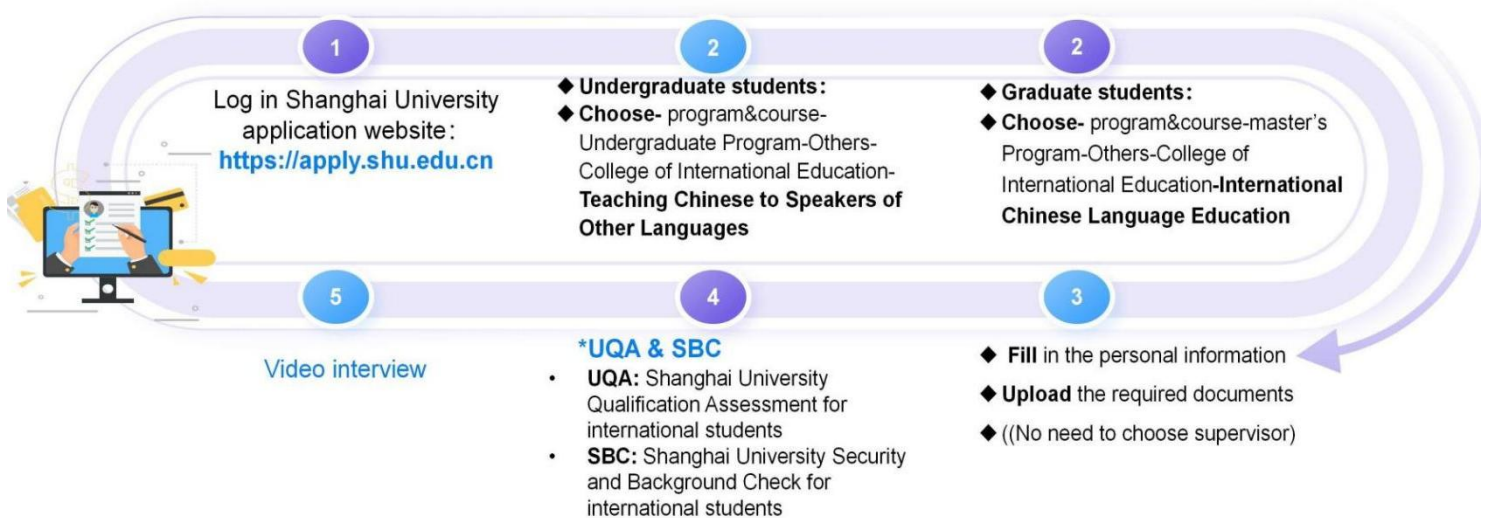

Scholarship recipients must complete the registration and enrollment on scheduled time in accordance with the university regulations. Those who miss the deadline without approval will be disqualified from scholarship.

Scholarship recipients must bring all original documents for registration (printed or photocopied documents are not accepted). Provision of any false/ misleading information or failure to provide the requested supporting documents will lead to disqualification of admission.

国际中文教师奖学金资助内容及标准

奖学金资助内容包括：学费、住宿费、生活费（四周研修生除外）和综合医疗保险费。

1. 学费由接收院校统筹用于奖学金生的培养与管理，开展文化活动，组织参加中文水平考试等。
2. 住宿费由接收院校统筹使用，为学生提供免费宿舍，一般为双人间；经奖学金生申请、接收院校批准，选择校外住宿者，由学校按月或季度发放住宿费，博士生标准为 1000 元人民币/月，其他类奖学金生为 700 元人民币/月。
3. 生活费由接收院校按月发放。本科生、一学年和一学期研修生标准为 2500 元人民币/月；国际中文教育专业硕士生为 3000 元人民币/月；国际中文教育专业博士生为 3500 元人民币/月。

奖学金生按接收院校录取通知书规定的时间入学报到，否则取消奖学金资格。当月 15 日（含 15 日）前到校注册者，当月发放全额生活费；15 日以后注册者，当月发放半月生活费。

奖学金生在学期间（不含寒暑假）因个人原因离开中国时间超过 15 天者，停发离华期间生活费。奖学金生因个人原因休学、退学或受接收院校纪律处分者，停发自休学、退学或接到处分通知之日起的生活费。

毕（结）业生的生活费发放至学校确定的毕（结）业日期后的半个月。

4. 综合医疗保险费参照中国教育部来华留学有关规定执行，由接收院校统一购买。四周研修生标准为 100 元人民币/人，一学期研修生为 400 元人民币/人，一学年以上标准为 800 元人民币/年/人。

Appendix 1

International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship Coverage and Standard

The scholarship covers tuition, accommodation fees, living allowance (excluding Four-Week Study Program students), and comprehensive medical insurance.

1. Tuition is managed comprehensively by the Host Institution for the training and management of scholarship students, the organization of cultural activities, and the administration of Chinese proficiency tests.
2. Accommodation fees are managed comprehensively by the Host Institution to provide free on-campus housing (generally double rooms) for students. If a scholarship student applies for and receives permission from the Host Institution to live off-campus, the Host Institution will issue a monthly or quarterly accommodation allowance. The allowance is RMB 1,000/month for doctoral students and RMB 700/month for other scholarship categories.
3. The living allowance is distributed by the Host Institution on a monthly basis. The standard rate for undergraduates, One-Year, and One-Semester students is RMB 2,500/month; for Master's students in International Chinese Language Education is RMB 3,000/month; and for Doctoral students in International Chinese Language Education is RMB 3,500/month.

Scholarship students must register at the Host Institution by the time stipulated in the Admission Letter; failure to do so will result in the cancellation of the scholarship.

Students who register on or before the 15th of the month will receive the full monthly allowance; those who register after the 15th will receive half of the monthly allowance.

If a scholarship student leaves China for personal reasons for more than 15 days during the study period (excluding winter and summer breaks), the living allowance will be suspended for the duration of their absence.

If a scholarship student suspends their studies, withdraws from school, or receives disciplinary action from the Host Institution for personal reasons, the living allowance will be suspended starting from the date of suspension, withdrawal, or penalty notification.

For graduating students, the living allowance is issued up to half a month after the graduation date confirmed by the school.

3. Comprehensive medical insurance expenses are implemented in accordance with relevant regulations from the Ministry of Education of China regarding international students studying in China and are purchased by the Host Institution. The standard for Four-Week Study Program students is RMB 100/person; for One-Semester Study Program students is RMB 400/person; and for students studying for more than one year is RMB 800/person/year.

Introduction of China Scholastic Competency Assessment

I. What is the CSCA?

The full name is the **China Scholastic Competency Assessment**.
The abbreviation is **CSCA** (China Scholastic Competency Assessment).
All information should be based on the official website of
CSCA: www.cscs.cn

II. Test Subjects

There are 5 subjects, taking a "mandatory + elective" mode. Divided into two categories: professional Chinese and basic subjects:

Category	Subject	Test Language	Duration	Question Types
Professional Chinese	Chinese Language for Liberal arts	Chinese	90 minutes	100 multiple-choice questions
	Professional Chinese for Science	Chinese	90 minutes	100 multiple-choice questions
Basic Subjects	Mathematics (mandatory)	Chinese/English	60 minute	48 multiple-choice questions
	Physics (elective)	Chinese/English	60 minute	48 multiple-choice questions
	Chemistry (elective)	Chinese/English	60 minute	48 multiple-choice questions

Important Notes:

- Mathematics** is a **mandatory subject** for everyone.
- Students applying for Chinese-taught majors (excluding BA of Chinese Language) must take the professional Chinese exam according to their major direction (liberal arts/science).
- Students applying for English-taught undergraduate majors and BA of Chinese Language do not need to take the professional Chinese exam.
- Students applying for majors in science, engineering, agriculture, and medicine usually need to take at least one subject from physics and chemistry.

III. Test Time and Format

- The first Global exam: **December 21, 2025**.
- Starting from 2026, the exam will be held **5 times a year**, in **January, March, April, June, and December**.
- Test format: Home-based online exam** is the main method, and offline test centers are set up in some countries (Vietnam and Thailand will be the first to establish offline test centers in 2025).



IV. Registration and Fees

- Registration time:** Registration for the first exam opens in November 2025.
- Registration method:** Mainly through the **online registration** on the CSCA official website: www.cscs.cn.
- Test fees:**
 - ◆ Single subject: 450 RMB;
 - ◆ Two or more subjects: 700 RMB
- Payment methods:** Support Alipay, WeChat, UnionPay, VISA, MasterCard, etc.

V. Score Report

- All subjects use a 100-point system.**
- Score release:**
 - Online/Computer-based exam:** within 7 working days after the exam;
 - Paper-based exam:** within 14 working days after the exam

VI. Important Attention

- CSCA scores are required materials for applying to undergraduate programs at our university. If you do not have a score report during the application stage, you can submit a registration screenshot first and then submit the formal score report **before June 30th**.
- CSCA scores are an important reference for admission and scholarship evaluation. The major of admission will be decided based on your comprehensive performance in each subject.
